Design Intuition - I consistently brainstorm good ideas in team settings. I trust my gut instinct on the vibe and composition of the design.

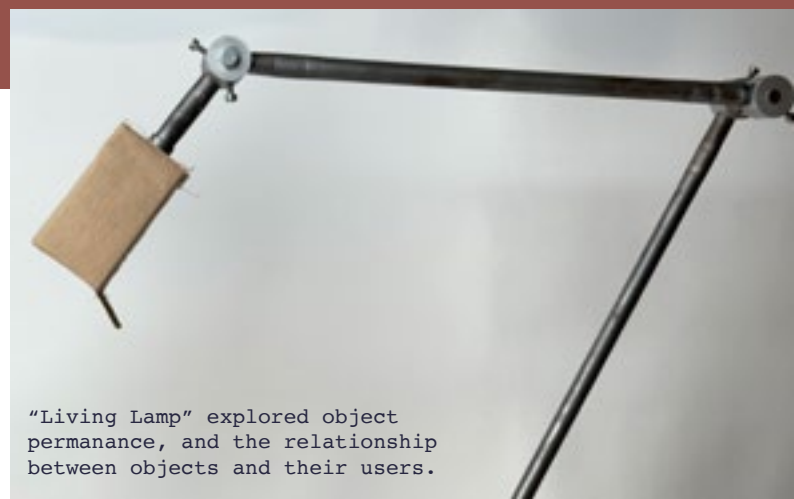
Drawing - Confident in conceptual sketching and detailed technical drawing. This is supported by regular observational drawing practice.
